

Hello PFSC Member,

One of the benefits of being a Pittsburgh Figure Skating Club (PFSC) member is we offer club ice to members on Sundays. This year's Club Ice Sessions will be starting before you know it! This season we are once again offering a pre-paid Club Ice package to our members.

For a flat rate of \$375 (per member), you can skate on **ALL PFSC Club Ice Sessions!**

While this is an increase over previous seasons, offering ice at this price, the club subsidizes more than half the cost of the ice time. We will be offering 75 half sessions over the course of the season and the cost per half session is just \$5 to you.

The sessions are on Sundays from 2:30 pm – 3:00pm (Session 1) , 3:00 – 3:25 pm (Session 2) and 3:25 – 3:50 pm (Session 3) starting on Sunday, September 10, 2023 with the following schedule (subject to change):

September 10, 17

October 1, 8, 15, 22, 29

November 5, 12, 19

December 10, 17

January 7, 21, 28

February 4, 11, 18, 25

March 3, 10, 17

April 7, 14, 21

The standard pricing for members who do not purchase a prepaid package is \$12 for 2 half sessions or \$20 for 3 half sessions.

The Club Ice package can be purchased through the PFSC Membership Entry site (<https://comp.entryeeze.com/Membership/Welcome.aspx?cid=203>) at any time throughout the season for \$150. There will be no prorated packages.

The Club Ice package CANNOT be purchased through Guest Services/Front Desk at the rink. The package is not transferrable to RMU Freestyle sessions, nor are RMU Freestyle package sessions transferrable to Club Ice.

Should the number of skaters be limited during any session due to COVID-19 precautions/mandates, skaters will be permitted to use the ice on a first-come first-served basis until the maximum number is achieved. There will be no refunds or partial refunds given related to the ice reaching maximum capacity.

In the event that multiple sessions would be cancelled due to COVID-19 mandates, the PFSC Board of Directors will review and determine applicable refunds as appropriate.

We hope many PFSC members take advantage of this Club Ice package opportunity, as it can provide a great financial option for those that use Club Ice sessions.
